VI International Poetry Contest in Jotabé Rhyme is destined to make Jotabé Rhyme public for everyone in all poetic, literary and artistic fields. Jotabé Rhyme was created by the poet Juan Benito Rodríguez Manzanres, Grand Mayor Master of the Juan Benito Literary-Poetic Order, organizing of this VI Contest, which is governed by the following rules.

## Rules of the, VI International Poetry Contest in Jotabé Rhyme

- 01.- All participating poems without exception will be composed in Jotabé Rhyme or one of its variants Jotabeí, Jotabém, Jotabeím, Jotabéa or Jotabeía.   - 02.- Any poet of any nationality, place of residence and age may participate.
  - 03.- There are two categories of participation in the Contest.
  - a) Poems written in Spanish language.
- b) Poems written in languages other than Spanish. Poems written in languages other than Spanish will be accompanied by their Spanish translation.
- 04.- Each poet may submit to the contest all those poems he desires, being these free theme, original and unpublished even in Internet.
  - 05.- The fund will be valued as much as the form, technique and message.
- 06.- A poet can only get a prize, so if he obtains more than one prize, his winning poem will be the best placed in the score ranking.
- 07.- Poems will be submited with real name in the email,

  The poem or poems will be written in the body of the e-mail. Then, you must write "VI International Poetry Contest in Jotabé Rhyme" in the subject. Acknowledgment of receipt will be sent to all participants.
- 08.- Deadline for submission of poems starts on November 25, 2016 at 00:01 am (Spanish time), and ends on February 28, 2017 at 23:59 hours (Spanish hour), both inclusive.
- 09.- Contest management will contact the winning poets through poem/s shipping address, requesting the full name and country of origin. Ten days after the notice, if the poet had not answered, it is understood to have waived their prize.
  - 10.- Prizes. The following prizes are established.

- 14.- All participants in doing so, admit to know and accept the rules that govern this contest.
- 15.- For any aspect not covered in these rules, will always prevail in every way the criterion of the organization.
